

TYPE OF VISIT/TOUR

MONA offers three types of school visits/tours. Educators are invited to schedule self-guided tours, guided docent tours, or a learning workshop, which is a guided docent tour with a creative art experience in our Community Studio.

*Chaperones are required for all school groups. Chaperone ratios are 1:6 for PreK - K, 1:10 for 1st-3rd and 1:15 for 4th-12th. No charge for educators and chaperones.
